If you are interested in showing cattle next year, it is time to decide. The show calf buying season has begun and will run until validation in June. Lambs will begin to start selling very soon, goats will be available late spring and into summer, pigs will begin selling late summer into the fall, and rabbit breeders will start taking orders for the county show around the time school starts back in the fall.

Please let the Extension Office know by <u>April 1st</u> if you plan on showing steers and heifers at major shows for the 2019 season and if you are planning on taking any animals to the 2018 State Fair of Texas.

Spring Contest

Preparations for spring contest are underway with many practices starting soon or already begun. Horse Validation

The validation process for horse shows started March 1st and is on 4-H Connect. You will need to upload pictures of your horses, registration papers if the horse is registered, and a current negative coggins test. Cost to validate a horse is \$10 per head from <u>now until April</u> <u>15th</u>. After that, the price increases to \$20 per horse through <u>May 1st</u>. If you have any questions about the validation process, or need help uploading your validation information to 4-H Connect, please contact the office.

County Show Checks

County Show checks have been available since February 16th at the Extension Office. Checks can be picked up anytime during business hours by the exhibitor or their parents/guardians.

When bringing your thank you notes in, we kindly ask that you have them ready for the mail by addressing and stamping each one.
