Livestock Validation Schedule

With major shows coming to a close for the year, it's time to start planning next year's livestock projects. If you are interested in showing cattle next year, it is time to decide. The show calf buying season has begun and will run until validation in June. Lambs will begin to start selling very soon, goats will be available late spring and into summer, pigs will begin selling late summer into the fall, and rabbit breeders will start taking orders for the county show around the time school starts back in the fall.

Rifle Practice

Rifle practice begins this Wednesday, March 27th, right after school. Please make sure to have your signed release forms turned into Brandon or L'Rae. No 4-H member will be allowed to shoot until we have the forms in the office. If you need release forms, please contact the Extension Office and we can get them to you. We will practice after school on April 3rd, April 17th and April 24th. The District contest is April 27th in Wichita Falls.

Horse Validation

The validation process for horse shows started March 1st and is on 4-H Connect. You will need to upload pictures of your horses, registration papers if the horse is registered, and a current negative coggins test. Cost to validate a horse is \$10 per head from **now until April 15th**. After that, the price increases to \$20 per horse through **May 1st**. If you have any questions about the validation process, or need help uploading your validation information to 4-H Connect, please contact the office.
