## Sheep and Goat Tag Orders

If you plan on showing a market or breeding lamb or goat at any of the Spring major livestock shows, the deadline to contact the Extension Office or Mr. Hernandez, Jayton ISD ag teacher, will be August 26<sup>th</sup>. Tags will be \$15 each.

Remember lamb and goat validation will be in October. We will notify everyone as soon as a date is set.

## Rally Night & 4-H Enrollment

It is time to sign up for the new 4-H year! You should have received an email with an enrollment form, but forms are always available by contacting the Extension Office.

August 6<sup>th</sup> we will hold Rally Night at the Jayton Pool from 6:30 to 9. So come on out, bring a friend, complete your enrollment form, swim and enjoy a hot dog supper!

## Changes for Major Shows -Lamb And Goats Exhibitors

1. **Texas Lamb Breeders Association (TLBA)** tag numbers **MUST** be in the lamb's ear and be recorded on the validation form at validation and be on the form at the time they are submitted. **NO** TLBA tag numbers will be added to the validation forms after the forms are submitted to the Sheep and Goat Validation of Texas program. Market lambs must have a yellow TLBA tag to be eligible to compete in the San Angelo Stock Show or receive TLBA recognition at other major shows. Wether dams must have a red TLBA ewe lamb tag to be eligible to compete in the San Angelo Wether Dam Show.
2. **The Texas Goat Breeders Association (TGBA)** is new this year. TGBA tag numbers must be in the goat's ear and recorded on the validation form at the time of validation. Market goats and wether does are eligible for this program and will have the same green TGBA tag. The TGBA tag is not required for entry into any show this year, but premiums will be awarded to exhibitors with TGBA tags.

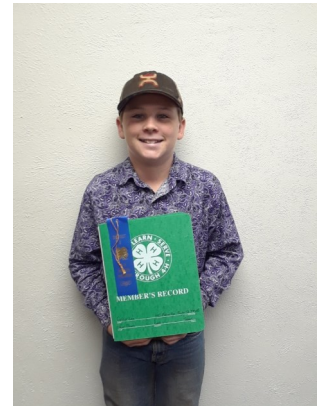
