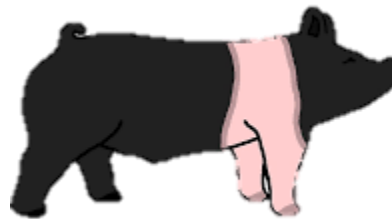

Swine Tags

Tag orders for the 2021-2022 stock show season will be due to the Extension Office on **September 24, 2021**. Any hogs shown at any major show must be validated with a state tag.

King County Fair

The King County Fair will be Saturday, October 16th. Entries, with payment, are due October 8th. Meat goats (wether & does), market lambs (wether & ewes) and beef cattle (heifers & steers). No limit to number of animals shown. Entry fees: Goats: \$10/head, Lambs \$10/head, Cattle \$20/head, Showmanship \$5 at the gate (cash only). We have entry forms and general rules at the office.

Major Livestock Show Exhibitors ONLY:



If you are entering the 3rd, 6th, or 9th grade this fall, or you will be attending major shows for the first time, you must take (or retake) the Quality Counts course to show your livestock project. This course must be completed by the entry deadline of the show you are planning to enter.
