No limit to number of animals shown. Entry fees: Goats: \$10/head, Lambs \$10/head, Cattle \$20/head, Showmanship \$5 at the gate (cash only). We have entry forms and general rules at the office.



Major Livestock Show Exhibitors ONLY:

If you are entering the 3rd, 6th, or 9th grade this fall, or you will be attending major shows for the first time, you must take (or retake) the Quality Counts course to show your livestock project. This course must be completed by the entry deadline of the show you are planning to enter.
