## Kent County Livestock Show Projects

Many of you have your livestock projects and others will be brining them home soon. Just a few things to think about as you begin your project:

- Health-Establish a vet-client relationship, make sure your animal is up to date on vaccinations, and watch for signs of external and internal parasites.
- Feeding-Talk to your breeder before you pick your animals up to ensure a smooth transition if you want to switch feeds. If you need help selecting a feed or supplements, ask the breeder their recommendations or reach out to Mr. Cave or Mr. Hernandez.
- Management-Begin showmanship early, spend time with your animals daily! Introduce an exercise program and develop that into a consistent routine. Groom your animals and trim hooves as needed. If you notice a problem with your animal, call when you do. Early intervention is vital to your animal's health.

If you have any questions or concerns about your animals, you can reach out to Mr. Cave or Mr. Hernandez. Take time to visit with older members and their families about your project to learn as much as you can.
