2022 Texas 4-H Horse Validation

If you plan to participate in the District or State Horse Show, it's time to get your horses validated. From March 1st-April 15th, the validation cost for each horse is \$10. April 16th-May 1st, the validation cost for each horse is \$20.

There is no limit to the number of horses that can be validated. You are encouraged to validate all horses that may possibly be shown at district and/or state shows. Only state validated horses can be substituted if a horse becomes unusable due to lameness, sickness, etc.

Photography Contest

If you'd like to submit pictures for the District 3 4-H contest, those need to be emailed or brought to L'Rae on a flash drive by April 1st.

Photo Eligibility: Photos must be taken by participants between the dates of January 1, 2021 and the time of entry.

Categories: Animals (Domestic), Animals (Wildlife), Catch-All, Details & Macro, Elements of Design, Enhanced, Food, Landscape & Nature (Non-Animal), Leading Line, Long Exposure, Motion/Action, People, Plant/Flora, Shadow/Silhouette, and Theme ("My Hometown").
